Nebraska -- A boy in Nebraska was happy to get a video game system for Christmas, but an image on that system led his father to be anything but pleased. Ten-year-old Kade Goodman wanted a PSP player, a hand-held PlayStation portable, like his brothers, so his father Shon Goodman, went to a local video store looking for a used unit at an affordable price, reported KETV-TV. When Kade's older brother was checking through the player, he found an image of a man's penis. "He went to themes and colors and pulled up a picture. It's something that's not meant to be seen by a child's eye," said the dad to the station. The father tried to remove the image, but when he couldn't, he got

more upset about it. Goodman brought the player back to the store, CD Tradepost. The store was able to remove the image and also gave the family a free game. The store said they try to make sure images stored on gaming systems are erased before reselling them. In April, a Florida woman purchased a PSP player from Wal-Mart for her 6-year-old son. When he turned on the game for the first time, he found an image of a naked woman. His mother then found a memory card inside the player containing hundreds of pornographic pictures. 3 wives in 3 different cities?

During a single week in August, the world of Faye Miller, a 51-year-old stay-at-home mom in Rochester Hills, came crashing down when she started to examine her marriage at the suggestion of her therapist. Through Google and phone records searches she learned:

- Her husband of 10 years, Dr. Kenneth Mitchell, a metro Detroit podiatrist, already had a wife in California when he married her in 1999.
- And in 2003 he had married yet another woman, a podiatrist in Quebec.

Equally astonishing, Mitchell, 48, a practicing Protestant who belongs to a Lutheran church with Miller, had converted to Islam in 2002, taken the Arabic name Mustafa and traveled twice to Saudi

Arabia on religious pilgrimages, according to court records. Mitchell, who operates several podiatry clinics in metro Detroit, declined through his attorney to talk with the Free Press. But in court filings he says he thought he was divorced from his first wife, and that the third marriage was never finalized because the necessary papers were not filed. "I just thought he was working a lot of hours and away at medical conferences," Miller said in a recent interview at her attorneys' office in Bingham Farms. "It was devastating. It brought me to my knees." She is seeking an annulment from Mitchell and child support for their two children. A hearing is set for Jan. 28.
